His other works include Gone for Good, The Innocent, The Woods, Hold Tight, Caught, Stay Close, Six Years, Missing You, The Stranger, Fool Me Once, Home, and Don't Let Go. Tell No One was turned into the multiple award-winning 2006 French film Ne le Dis à Personne. He was the first author to win the Edgar Award, Shamus Award, and Anthony Award.

- Awards - that the title has been nominated for and/or has won


If you find a title or author you would like to explore more, click on a title or a button it and you will be taken to those records in the catalogue. You can then place holds on any titles you are interested in.
