- 5. Bookings are essential. Limit of 12 scarecrows (one per family; any number of children to age 15years; parental help allowed)
- 6. The winner, chosen by library representatives, wins a Bunnings voucher valued at \$100
- 7. Voting for People's Choice Award is between Sunday 1st May and 4pm Sunday 8th May

- Entrants must be a member of Casey Cardinia Libraries
- One entry per family
- The competition is only open to library members
- Competition opens Monday 4th April 2022 at 9 am (AESDT)
- Entries close Saturday 30th April 2022 at 3 pm (AESDT)
- The winner will be chosen by library representatives.
- Voting for People's Choice Award is between Sunday 1st May and 4pm Sunday 8th May 2022
- All winners will be notified by Tuesday 31st May 2022
- The prize is a Bunnings voucher valued at \$100
- The Bunnings voucher is not refundable or transferrable for cash
- People's Choice prize is a makers/creator's box packaged by Library staff
- CCL isnt responsible for any damage to the scarecrow while on display
