Activities

EGG CARTON FRO-YO

Materials:

- Egg cartons
 - Central cones cut out of egg carton
 - Small, intact egg carton (optional)
- Coloured cotton wool balls
- Glue
- Small pom poms (optional)
- Glitter (optional)
- Flavour board (optional)

Method:

1. Children could help decide which flavours we are using today. These could be written on the 'fro-yo' display board.
For example, white could be vanilla or coconut. Brown could be chocolate.
2. Children should pick their frozen yogurt (fro-yo) flavour, which is represented by the different coloured cotton balls.
3. Glue the cotton wool so it partially sticks inside the cut out cone.
4. If using pom poms and glitter, these would be toppings for the fro-yo.
5. If using, the fro-yo cone could be placed inside the small egg carton. Children could decorate their cone holders. They could also pretend to sell their fro-yo.

JUNIOR CHEFS

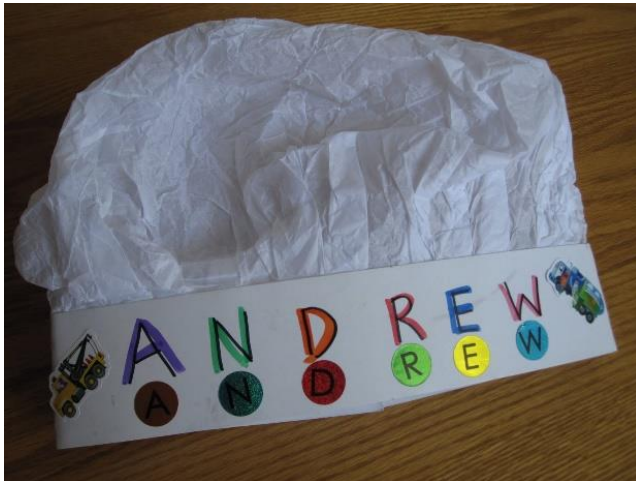
Materials:

- Chef hat
- Textas/pencils

Method:

1. Ensure each child gets a chef's hat.
2. Ask children to draw their favourite fruits and veggies on their chef's hat.
3. Encourage parents/carers to help.
4. Suggest children wear their hats while helping in the kitchen.

PAPER PLATE SPAGHETTI

Materials:

- Paper plate
- Red tissue paper
- Glue
- Scissors
- Brown paper
- Yellow or cream coloured wool

Method:

1. Cut the red tissue paper into squares.
2. Glue the red squares – your sauce – onto a paper plate. Ensure the plate is covered in sauce!
3. Rub glue to the top of the sauce.
4. Cut and place wool – the spaghetti – on top of the sauce.
5. Cut out small circles from the brown paper. These are going to be the meatballs.
6. Glue the meatballs to the top of the spaghetti.

WATERMELON PIZZA

Materials (fruits to be precut):

- Watermelon
- Yogurt
- Assortment of fruit
- Paper plates
- Plastic spoons

Method:

1. Children start making their pizza by spreading yogurt over a slice of watermelon.
