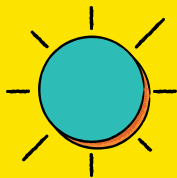

Create Your Own Watercolour Christmas Cards Workshop for Adults

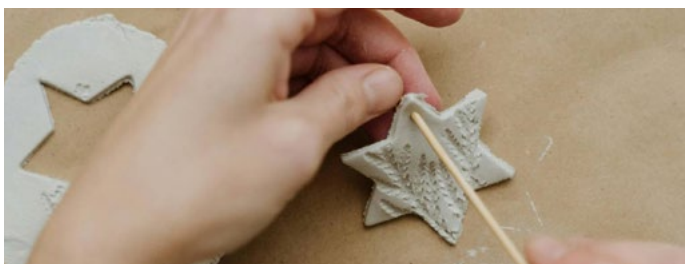
Festive fun where you will create your own Christmas card designs using watercolour paints. A hands on, practical workshop.
