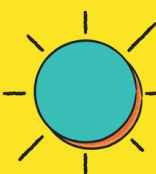
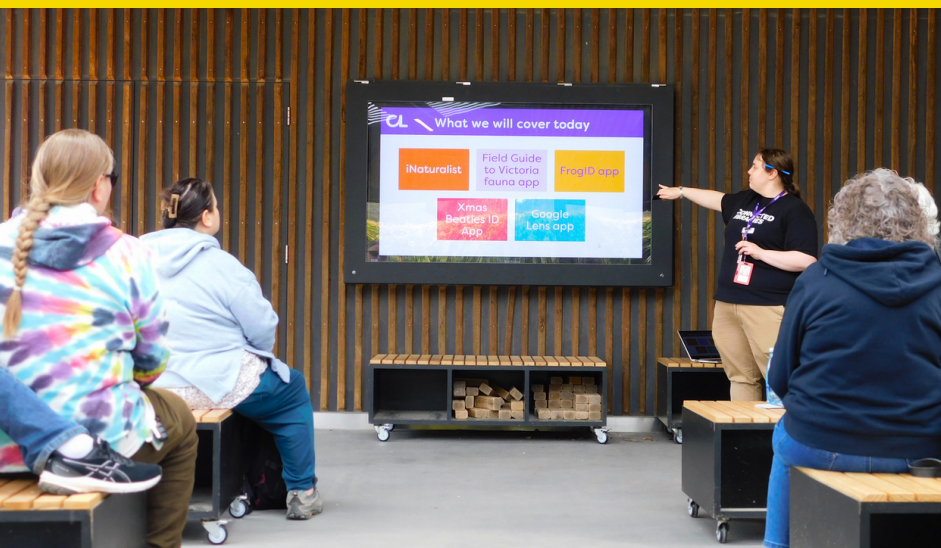


Digital Literacy Summer Workshops
